Welcome to the third community newsletter for the proposals to relocate Brentford Football Club.

The updated proposals for the redevelopment of Lionel Road South site were presented at a second public consultation exhibition in March, which was attended by over 240 people. Since the last exhibition we have continued to meet and engage with a wide range of local groups in the area to share our proposals and receive valuable feedback.

The Club are now ready to submit a planning application to Hounslow Council. We will be applying for detailed planning permission for the purpose built community stadium and outline planning permission for the residential enabling developments.

We would like to invite you to our third public consultation exhibition to present the finalised proposals of our scheme.
